Alpha is a coefficient measuring the portion of a fund's return arising from specific (non-market) risk. **Beta** illustrates a fund's sensitivity to price movements in relation to a benchmark index. **R-Squared** is a statistical measure that represents the percentage of a fund's movements that can be explained by movements in a benchmark index. **Standard Deviation** is a statistical measurement that helps to gauge the fund's historical volatility.

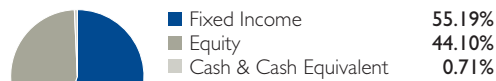

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Investment Strategy

This investment option invests in a portfolio whose sub-adviser, Aegon USA Investment Management, LLC (AUIM), seeks to achieve the portfolio's objective by investing its assets primarily in a combination of underlying exchange traded funds (ETFs). Under normal circumstances, AUIM expects to allocate substantially all of the portfolio's assets among underlying ETFs to achieve targeted exposure to domestic equities, international equities and domestic bonds. AUIM expects that, over the long-term, the portfolio's allocation will average approximately 50% of portfolio assets in ETFs that invest primarily in global equities and approximately 50% of portfolio assets in ETFs that invest primarily in U.S. fixed income securities.

Variable annuities are long-term tax deferred vehicles designed for retirement purposes. They offer three main benefits: tax-deferred treatment of earnings, guaranteed death benefit options, and guaranteed lifetime payout options.
